Anson Mills was born in 1834. During his lifetime he achieved the rank of Brigadier General in the US Army, partaking in the United States Civil War and the American Indian Wars. Mills was not only a soldier but an avid investor, businessman, and connoisseur. He had a significant influence in our city. Most notably naming our town El Paso. The following Cocktail Menu provides a brief outline of the life led by Anson Mills; the man who had this historic building built.

Mills is born in Thornton Indiana.

ANSON - Smoked Old Fashioned featuring Knob Creek Rye, Angostura bitters and a sugar cube. \$16

Mills visits El Paso for the first time. Formerly named Franklin. Successfully suggests new name.

FRANKLIN - Tamarindo margarita, made with fresh tamarind and lime juice. Choose either Rio Revuelto Mezcal or Maestro Dobel Diamante Tequila. \$17

Mills, a lieutenant in the Union Army, participates in one of the most pivotal battles of the American Civil War. SHILOH - Caribbean Cable Car. Made with Myers Rum, Cointreau, fresh lemon juice, and a hint of guava. \$16

Mills earns his fortune after inventing the leather cartridge belt.

CARTRIDGE BELT -

New York Sour featuring Woodford Reserve, lemon juice, egg white and Malbec wine. \$16

Anson marries Hannah Cassel and together have three children.

CASSEL - Dragon Fruit Martini made with Absolut Citron and a splash of St. Germain. Finished with a breath of fire. \$16

Mills is present during the Great Sioux War.

ROSEBUD - Gin Fiz with a refreshing twist. Featuring Empress gin, egg white, and pomegranate. \$16

The Anson Mills building is constructed.

MILLS - Boulevardier made with Makers Mark 46. Featuring a fiery presentation. \$17
